Dear Mrs Saunders

With reference to your letter dated 18th April, I make the following comments.



#### **Corn Storage**

I propose to buy in 25 tonnes of barley for this coming winter feed. I would also look to plant 10 acres of winter barley this year in the field marked A on the enclosed drawing no. 1507-3A, subject to obtaining planning approval.

#### **Hay Production**

I will be producing in the region of 1000 small bales for winter fodder for my 200 breeding ewes; any surplus will be sold on. Also 100 bales of haylage along with 200 big bales of hay in the following fields marked B, also indicated on the enclosed drawing no. 1507-3A, a total of 20 acres. I can confirm all the hay machinery is owned by Teydale Farming Ltd.

#### **Building Design**

The building is a standard agricultural building design manufactured by J. Wareing and Sons (Wrea Green) Ltd as stated on plan number P6262-01. The internal layout is shown on revised plan number P626.01/2

With regard to the location of the building I felt this was the best location as the building would be screened from 3 sides.

With regard to the view from the South, I propose planting the existing 2.5 metre high bund on the southern boundary with indigenous trees to afford further screening of the building.

With regard to your comment on the isolated location, I do not consider the site to be isolated as it is 150 meters from The Wath and linked by a pathway. One the Directors of Teydale Farming Ltd, who lives at The Wath will be responsible for the day to day site management.

I also include a copy of my Certificate of Incorporation for Teydale Farming Ltd for your records.
