I raise no objection to the current scheme of works proposed but ask that the historic door be kept in its location rather than repositioned, this should enable hallway to read as if not alterations have taken place.

Further to this I ask that if plaster is to be reinstated to the historic fabric that it should be a traditional lime plaster – the mix of which should be submitted to the Authority for approval. This will not include plaster for the stud walls.

The listed building description is not a heritage statement and as such the documentation provided with the application does not meet the standards of assessing significance set out in the NPPF (2019). The applicant suggested there may be further applications as part of an ongoing scheme of refurbishment works. In this regard I draw his attention to the Conservation Principals document by Historic England that sets out how heritage significance – looking at the heritage values is assessed.
