Dear Ailsa,

I think these are the final two pieces of information.

1. Disabled access: Having spoken to building regs, they will be happy with a wooden ramp that is not fixed for wheel chair access. We think wooden is better as it will go with the building rather than metal. It will only be put out when needed. I have spoken to Botton Village and I think they will be making it.
2. Front Gates: The same stone posts and wooden gates will remain. We would like to move the stone pillars a further 36 cm's apart (so 18 cm's each side). In this way the man gate entrance will go from 278 cm's width to 314cm's width.
