Re: South Beck Cottage, Scalby, YO13 0QY  
Planning Ref: NYM/2018/0213/FL.

In October last year (see emails of 23<sup>rd</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> Oct 2018) we had an exchange of emails re changing the cladding on our new porch and replacement conservatory from Corten steel to (probably) cedar. You confirmed that, while you preferred the crisp look of the steel you would be able to accept the cedar alternative provided it was covered by an application for a non-material minor amendment.

Since then, while the building works have been progressing, we were thrown by a meeting with an industrial cladding consultant, Pashby ICC, who is one of the few people in the north to have extensive experience

in the use of Corten steel. In his view, while it is a great material where you have extensive unbroken surfaces, as soon as you have to introduce curves or openings for windows and doors at a relatively small (ie domestic) scale it becomes extremely difficult to work. As a result of his advice we would like to come back to the use of cedar cladding as previously discussed. To that end we have enclosed a revised drawing from Bramhall Blankham (Dwg N° 1329 AR50 or Rev. J) as requested. A sample of the western red cedar can be viewed on site if you are in the area but I'm sure you are familiar with it already.

We look forward to receipt of your formal approval shortly. Please let us know if you have any queries.
