Work to tree protected by TPO 2012/2 Sunny Bank, Hackness

I refer to your application dated 2 October 2019 to carry out work on a tree protected by the above Tree Preservation Order.

I can now confirm that the North York Moors National Park Authority consents to the following work:

- T2 Lime (the easterly tree of the pair) – Prune significant lateral growth back to the primary branch on the south side of the tree, retaining as far as is practical any minor growth to retain the viability of this primary branch.

This permission is subject to the following conditions:

- That all tree works shall be carried out in accordance with *British Standard 3998:2010, Tree Work- Recommendations*;
- That work shall be carried out within a period of two years from the date of this letter (or else a new and separate application will be necessary).
