Hi Rob,

The road verges surrounding the site where the proposed southern end of the footpath is to connect into the existing PROW network are amongst our most botanically diverse in the National park. Whilst I do not believe the works to insert a crossing point and permit walkers to use a cross point across the verge here is likely to constitute a significant impact, it will be important that any works are sensitively done, and that precautions are taken to avoid any unnecessary ground disturbance or spillage of materials (eg if concrete is being used to secure posts). Preferably, any works required would be avoided between April and August during which the majority of the plants will flower and set seed.
