We would like to put on record our concern regarding the water supply for the above applications for the redevelopment of Centre Farm, Old Battersby

We have lived in one of the three properties with water supplied by Northumbrian Water for 20 years. During that time we have had a variety of plumbing jobs carried out by John Bell, Osmotherley. We understand from Mr Bell that our water pressure is adequate **but not good**. We have real concerns therefore that a further three dwellings being supplied by the existing Northumbrian Water supply will have a detrimental effect on our water pressure.

We ask you to give serious consideration to our objection to the above planning applications on the grounds that they may adversely affect the water pressure to the three properties connected to the Northumbrian Water supply.
