

Checklist and Guidance Note for Prior Notification of Agricultural Development (Buildings, Roads, Excavation/Deposit of Waste Material From Farm, Fish Tank)

Important Information

The plans submitted as part of any notification considered by the Planning Committee will be scanned and possibly used in a slide presentation of the scheme. It is essential, therefore, that the plans are sufficiently clear so that the details of the proposal can be easily seen when projected onto the screen.
