It is understood that this rooflight is required for means of escape and that all other options to provide this have been assessed and discounted. As such, the insertion of a single rooflight is acceptable in this instance.

While i have no objection to the top hung opening method, i do object to the use of this product manufacturer as their detailing is not traditional and often have a much bulkier profile and appearance. I accept that this manufacturer has been used in past conversions at the site, however we do not now support their use. Instead we would recommend rooflights provided by The Rooflight Company, Lumens or Clements.
