### NYM/2020/0115/FL Field north of Keld Runnels Road, Scalby Nabs, Suffield

The development proposed is adjacent to a large, prominent and isolated tree. There are no details of the tree but I estimate that the centre of the tree is less than 8m from the development. The proposal sensibly keeps some distance from the tree and the access route (and I assume services provision) is well away from the tree.

Given that this is a tree of landscape value and to some extent mitigates the impact of the proposal I would like the applicant to confirm if the development is outside the root protection area (RPA) of this tree. This is an open grown tree and the roots would be expected to go some way beyond the crown spread and indeed the theoretical RPA. From the photo I would guess that the RPA is greater than an 8m radius.

In addition it would be sensible to locate the equipment far enough away for any potential failure to make contact. I assume the tree will continue to grow and the mast will be in place for many years. It would be a shame to have to remove the tree in the future because it presented a hazard to the equipment if this could easily be located at greater distance.
