We have the following comments to the proposal Reference: NYM/2018/0843/FL.

Faceby lodge Cottages (now Faceby Lodge) has right of access at all times across Faceby Lodge Farm roadway to A172. We note the Development proposes upgrade works to the roadway (aspects of which are unclear), construction of new passing places and A172 upgrade works. For the latter we note that the development considers a forced closure is required and as such is in direct contravention to the access rights granted to Faceby Lodge. Therefore we object to any development restrictions imposed to the access between Faceby Lodge and the A172.

We consider that the Development OS boundary and ownership plan is not an accurate indication of the actual ownership boundaries. The land registry records indicate that the boundary for Faceby Lodge is actually at the junction of the property access road and the Roadway to Faceby lodge Farm. We also note that the development is considering works in Document titled "Indicative access road cross sections" dated 4 March 2019 and therefore we object to any such work undertaken at this location which is not in accordance with ownership boundaries.

We have strong concerns regarding that such a large scale development is out of character for the location and will result in an overall severe negative impact to the current tranquillity and nature of the existing agricultural/rural location or to that expected from agricultural activities regarding noise, disturbance, nuisance and light pollution. This will be exacerbated by the elevated site location.

The elevated development is directly visible from Faceby Lodge and as such should not detract from the current visage and any landscaping should provide sufficient screening that respects the simple rural character of a farm.

The current BT cable providing services to Faceby Lodge is located adjacent to the farm roadway in the vicinity of proposed development works which is to remain in service at all times.

It is unclear regarding suitable provisions for Barn Owls under the Development but we can confirm Barn Owls are resident and observed as recently as Saturday 9 March. During our occupation at Faceby Lodge we have observed both breeding pairs with Owlets and Bats.

Concern regarding the order of magnitude of increase of vehicle movements from 2 to 27 vehicles notwithstanding additional service movements is considered a significant increase with impact to the roadway and surrounding area. In addition Contrary to statements made we are not aware of local services in the vicinity of the development (other than available in Carlton and Faceby villages) and traffic movements are likely to be underestimated for daily egress/access during occupation periods.

We register strong concerns about further development including provision of further amenities or recreational space
