I have no objection to this application, however I note that the field in which the barn is to be erected is known to have had records of Himalayan balsam in 2013 and 2016. Eradication of the balsam has not been reported. On this basis I would request that a condition is used to require appropriate biosecurity controls to be maintained during the construction phase when it is reasonable to assume a number of vehicle movements to and from the site will be required which could cause spread of seeds to other areas. Appropriate controls would include wheel washing of vehicles when leaving the site and inclusion of boot washing facilities for anybody working on the site. Spoil from the site should not be transferred elsewhere unless treated as potentially hazardous waste and disposed of appropriately.
