

Reasons for consent		

Trees are at varying stages of ash dieback disease, for those trees that are not at this stage dangerous the early removal will allow adjacent trees of other species to receive more light to improve their growth rate and form.

Given that some of the trees could be considered dangerous as the dieback is quite advanced all the trees may be removed at your earliest convenience. Given the density of existing trees in the area there is no requirement to plant replacement trees.
