

Further to our site meeting at the above address today, it is my opinion that the six Ash trees on the property are suffering from Ash dieback (chalara fraxinea), 2 of which are completely dead and the other 4 are dying. I strongly recommend that these trees are felled as soon as possible in the interests of health & safety, due to their close proximity to the highway (which is a main bus route) and public footpath.
