Extending the boundaries of the village in my view is not a bad thing to allow development which in turn will help the community by hopefully giving more interest to the church, school and village hall etc.

I would prefer to see individual designs for the proposed properties and think that 3 properties with different characteristics would look better.

With regard to extending the 30MPH limit further along Egton Lane, I would suggest that the speed limit should be extended further as there have been several road accidents due to excessive speed on this stretch of road.

I think that the speed limits should be applied regardless of the proposed development.
