Thank you for your letter of 01 October 2020 in connection with the above in relation to further air quality assessment. Whilst your letter is referenced to Building 2 we assume that would be more concerned with the larger of the two buildings i.e. Building 1 but do correct me if I am wrong.

We note that the request has not come from Natural England but from the Authority and it is acknowledged that there is to be no increase in cattle numbers.

An extensive and costly air quality assessment covering the whole site was submitted during the course of a previous application for the slurry lagoon and given that nothing has changed over the site including livestock numbers which have in fact marginally reduced the client wishes to put forward the same report again. It is not anticipated that the air quality has altered and therefore this baseline data for the site can be used unlike other sites where there currently is not data. Therefore I am grateful to submit the information prepared by Promar International.

With regard to your final request I can confirm that it is the planning statement that is correct and foul waste from the buildings will be directed to the new slurry lagoon where the waste will be easily stored without impact on the farms aquatics or minimum winter storage capacity which is capable of accommodating that for Building 1 and Building 2.

I trust that the above is useful and the application is able to be progressed.
