## Trees in Conservation Area – Midstream Cottage, Thornton le Dale

Thank you for the notification of your intention to carry out work to trees at Midstream Cottage which was received by this Office on 5 August 2020. I apologise for the delay in replying.

I can confirm that the North York Moors National Park Authority has no objection to the following work:

T1 Acacia – Remedial prune to re-balance crown

T2 Beech - Crown thin up to 15%

T3 Yew - Crown lift to 3 metres over beck

**T4 Spruce – Remove** 

T6 Ash - Remove

T7 Sycamore – Crown thin up to 10%

Reason for consent:

Tree removals are of trees in poor health and low amenity value, other works are for reasonable arboricultural interventions compatible with long term tree retention.

As stated in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas), the above permission is subject to a six week notification period, with the details recorded in a register open to public inspection. This six week period from the date of notification has now elapsed and therefore the work noted above may be carried out at your earliest convenience within a period of two years and without further reference to myself.
