The proposed building is in close proximity to a couple of drains which border the southwest and southeast edges of the site and ultimately discharge into the River Derwent. I note that the building is proposed to be sited at least 10m from the beck and that an exclusion construction zone is proposed for woodland protection reasons which will also help to ensure that pollution of the beck as a result of construction is prevented. This should be conditioned.

Any external lighting proposed should be reserved by condition to ensure no impact on dark skies qualities or nocturnal fauna.
