With regard to the planning application for the construction of a tree house for holiday letting accommodation at Stainsacre Hall, Stainsacre Lane, Whitby, my wife and I wish to raise our objections.

Within the Planning Application, the Design & Access Statement states in its introduction regarding Stainsacre Hall the following : -

'a local business man (John Collinson) took over the role of restoring the building to it's former glory. **This has involved transforming various outbuildings into holiday accommodation for other people to stay and enjoy the extensive land and woodland around the Hall itself.**

This states clearly that the intended plan is to create holiday accommodation at the Hall /Grounds.. I am aware that there is a holiday 'cottage' already in use at the Hall which is advertised on the web.

I thought Stainsacre Hall was a family home. Has a change of use been applied for? Are the National Park happy that a large family home is being transformed bit by bit into a holiday park? **I believe it very difficult to look at this planning application in isolation from the bigger picture and would welcome feedback from National Parks.**

In addition, we do not believe the village has the infrastructure to support a holiday park.

On these grounds we object to this planning application.
