Note to the Planning Officer:

In assessing the submitted proposals and reaching its recommendation the Local Highway Authority (LHA) has taken into account the following matters:

The access from the publicly maintained highway of Hawsker Lane is via a metalled bridle way. The current occupants of Brook House farm and other properties will also be using the same access along the bridle way to have vehicular access from Hawsker Lane.

With regards to the proposed caravan pitches, the applicant should ensure that the users of the caravans have the relevant rights of access along the public right of way.

With regards to the proposed equestrian areas, on the clear understanding that the application will be conditioned to remain ancillary to the main residence and to the caravan accommodation only, the LHA would not anticipate any significant intensification of traffic along the bridleway compared with current use of the farm buildings.

It should be noted that the LHA would have concerns if the equestrian areas are made into a commercial business and therefore generate more traffic. Although the applicant is not showing that they are in control of the access, they should investigate into the provision of passing places being constructed to allow vehicles to pass each other on the route from Hawsker Lane.
