Application is being made

(a) for consent under section 37 of the Electricity Act 1989 to install or keep installed an electric line above ground.

(b) for a direction under Section 90(2) OF THE TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 that planning permission for the proposed development be deemed to be granted.

1. Particulars of proposed development. In order to accommodate an upgraded new connection from single phase to three phase for the proprietor of Northcliffe and Sea View Holiday Parks, the Company proposed to upgrade 2 spans of the existing two conductor overhead line between pole 40 to the Hawsker Sea View transformer pole (pole 2) to three phase (three conductors) and extend this overhead line by two spans, as shown on the enclosed drawing "Plan 1". The existing and proposed lines are 11kV.

Pole 39 will be changed from a 10m stout to an 11m stout pole (not part of the three-phasing area, but required for clearance for the three-phased poles)

Pole 40 will be changed from an 11m stout to a 12m stout pole, keeping the existing 2 stay wires.

Pole 1 (between poles 40 and the Hawsker Sea View Transformer pole) will be changed from a 32ft light pole to a 12m stout pole, with the existing stay moved to a 9.4m spread and an aerial switch added.

The Hawsker Sea View transformer will be replaced from a split phase transformer to a 200kVA three phase transformer, and the pole changed from a 36ft extra stout pole to a 12m extra stout pole to accommodate this new transformer. The two existing stay wires will be removed.

The overhead line is then proposed to be extended north east by 2 spans from the Hawsker Sea View transformer pole, with one pole (new, pole 3) as a new 12m pole and ending with a new HV Terminal Pole, 12m stout (new, pole 4) with 2 stays in the proprietor's land at 9.4m spread. Underground cables will then run from this.

Please see attached "Plan 1". Existing apparatus is shown in black, new or improved apparatus in red and apparatus to be removed is in blue.
