Dear Megan

The accompanying bat report is thorough and largely suitable for purpose with the exception of the query below. As 2 days roosts were found a bat development licence will be required and conditions applied. I did however notice a discrepancy between the survey areas mapped within the bat report and the development areas as proposed on the plans that will need to be resolved before determination to ensure that all the buildings proposed for development have been adequately surveyed.

As you will see from pages 19, 21 and 23 of the Bat Survey Report, building 3 covers the **southern** half of the long north-south range of buildings. On the plans submitted D11412-08 and D11412-07 the **northern** half of this range is to be converted and not the southern half. Presuming the development plans are accurate, we will need further confirmation from the surveying ecologist as to the potential risk of bat roosting in the northern part of the long range of buildings which appears to have been excluded from survey to date, including, if appropriate, how well these areas of the range would have been covered during the emergence surveys and therefore whether further surveys will be necessary to exclude the probability of roosting within this part of the buildings.
