I have no major concerns having been consulted on bats previously, however as the development is proposed to drain to an existing septic tank, can we please obtain confirmation from the applicant that the tank has sufficient capacity for the additional use and discharges to a drainage field > 10m from a field drain or watercourse (septic tanks are no longer permitted to discharge to watercourse). Provided that confirmation is obtained, I have no objection and do not need to be consulted again.
