I have looked at the plans and the arboricultural report provided.

Three of the affected trees are BS category A1 and should be considered a significant constraint to development of the site.

In my opinion the proposed incursion into the root protection area (RPA) of T3 and T4 should be avoided. The RPA itself is a compromise measure between protecting trees and enabling development. It is therefore perfectly reasonable to insist that the developed area remains outside the RPA.

If there is no scope for repositioning or scaling back the development then given detail of the tree report I would suggest a reasonable compromise would be to retain the building in the current position but limit the yard to an area outside the RPA's. Given that the door to the shed is at the midpoint this should still allow for vehicular access to the building. The area within the RPA's should remain as grassland or semi-natural vegetation to conserve the rooting environment. The tree protection plan and arboricultural method statement should be revised to reflect this including a revised location for the tree protection fence.

Compliance with the revised method statement should be conditioned.

I am also concerned that the excavation back to historic levels within the RPA's of all the trees will put the trees at potential risk. I would therefore ask that we condition this work to be carried out under an arboricultural watching brief prior to construction of the building and yard commences.
