Trees in Conservation Area – Beech Hill, Aislaby

Thank you for the notification of your intention to carry out work to trees at Beech Hill which was received by this office on 13 April 2021. I apologise for the delay in sending you a formal reply.

I can confirm that the North York Moors National Park Authority has no objection to the following work:

Two groups of Leylandii to rear of house	Removal
Reasons for consent: Trees are to rear of property and are of limited amenity value	

If you are not the owner (usually the landowner of the land on which the tree stands) please ensure the owner is happy for you to carry out this work.

As stated in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas), the above permission is subject to a six week notification period, with the details recorded in a register open to public inspection. This six week period from the date of notification has now elapsed and therefore the work noted above can be carried out at your earliest convenience within a period of two years and without further reference to myself.
