After assessing the proposed amendments to the original permission, on the whole the details are acceptable. As i understand it, the proposed fascia boarding is limited to the sliding doors and is not proposed elsewhere.

My only concern is the amended design for the front door. Boarded doors are more traditional of small moorland farmsteads and cottages and would instead prefer to see a panelled door.

In terms of the window details, these are acceptable but can we request omission of the horn and use of putty shaped beads.
