Tree in Conservation Area – The Studio, Tommy Baxter Street, Robin Hood's Bay

Thank you for the notification of your intention to carry out work to a trees at The Studio which was received by this office on 28 July 2021.

I can confirm that the North York Moors National Park Authority has no objection to the following work:

T1 Sycamore	Removal
Reasons for consent: multi-stemmed sycamore is potentially unsuitable for long term	
retention at this location.	

As stated in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas), the above permission is subject to a six week notification period, with the details recorded in a register open to public inspection. Therefore, after a six week period from the date of notification has elapsed (which would mean after 7 September 2021) subject to no objections being received, the work noted above may be carried out within a period of two years without further reference to myself.
