## Dear Helen

I have no objection to the proposed development, however given it its located within the floodplain of the River Esk there is a risk that localised pollution of the river could be caused during the construction phase in the event of excessive rainfall or high river levels.

To minimise the risk of sediment or other pollutants entering the watercourse during construction of the garage, please can we include a pre-commencement condition for the submission of a Construction Environmental Management Plan, setting out the measures to be employed during the construction phase to ensure the aquatic environment is not deleteriously affected. This should include details such as how materials and sediment will be stored and moved, machinery storage and refuelling and so on.

If any external lighting is proposed, please can we include an external lighting condition.
