The proposed siting of this building appears to require the removal of mature trees and scrub based on the dimensions of the plan provided which does not fit into the area identified on the aerial image plan supplied. Can more clarity be sought as to whether trees and shrubs will need to be removed to enable the building to be built, and if so we will likely need more information on the scale of the potential losses and proposals for compensatory habitat to be planted.

Guttering will be required to ensure that any clean roof water is directed away from areas used by farm machinery/stock.
