Chapel Garth is set within a natural wooded setting and as such the expansion of hard standing/patio needs to be carefully considered so as not to create a harsh and hard lansdcaped appearance which would be harmful to the natural appearance of the Egton Bridge Conservation Area.

The proposed patio extension would be minimal in size and as such I have no objections to this. I wouldn't however want to see further expansion.

The resurfacing of the driveway is proposed to have a gravel finish and I have no objections to this.

Finally the scheme proposes the widening of the entrance by 300mm. The widening of entrances is not normally something which is supported, but given the small nature of this widening and that no splaying is proposed (i.e. it retains the opening as simple gap in an otherwise continuous wall) I have no objections in this instance as I don't consider this extent of removal would harm the wider Conservation Area.

I would however request that some form of gate is reinstated (ideally a 5-bar gate to match existing) and also whether consideration could be given to using a stone gate pier to replace the current metal pole?
