Trees in Conservation Area – rear of The Hollies, Lealholm

Thank you for the notification of your intention to carry out works to trees on land at the rear of The Hollies which was received by this office on 19 August 2021.

I can confirm that the North York Moors National Park Authority has no objection to the following work:

Three Ash	Remove or monolith
Reasons for consent - trees suffering from ash dieback disease and in unsuitable location for retention	

If you are not the owner (usually the landowner of the land on which the trees stand) please ensure the owner is happy for you to carry out this work.

As stated in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas), the above permission is subject to a six week notification period, with the details recorded in a register open to public inspection. This six week period from the date of notification has now elapsed and therefore the work noted above can be carried out at your earliest convenience within a period of two years and without further reference to myself.
