Consultee response:

Reviewing this application and the proposed works noted above, we approve with some conditions which the applicant needs to demonstrate/confirm before approval is granted.

Conditions:

- The new stones required for the wall need to match in grain and geology;
- The new stone wall height needs to be no higher than the immediate boundary walls;
- The new gate would be more in keeping if the style of the existing is replicated, the curved/projecting section on the proposed design is less in-keeping/traditional to the area.
- The applicant needs to confirm that the new wall is going to be rebuilt within the same footprint as the current one.

Once these conditions have been addressed we can review and finalize our decision.
