Dear Jill

The proposed huts are to connect to an existing septic tank which is shown on the supplied plan. The applicant states that the capacity has been checked to be adequate for the additional load. I am concerned regarding the location of the existing tank, which appears to be immediately adjacent to the beck which borders the property to the southwest. Septic tanks used to be permitted to discharge direct to watercourse, but are no longer legally allowed to do so due to new regulations regarding discharges from septic tank that came into force in January 2020. To accord with the regulations, all septic tanks must be connected to a suitable drainage field at least 10m away from any watercourse or drain. Given the apparent proximity of the tank to the stream, it appears unlikely that this tank is compliant with the new regulations, unless the applicant can provide evidence to the contrary.

I would therefore advise that the septic tank should either be moved or replaced with a package treatment plant that is able to discharge directly to watercourse. I believe there are also now products available on the market that can be retrofitted to certain septic tanks to turn them into a package treatment plant which may be an option.

If approved, please include an external lighting condition to reserve details of any lighting installed to ensure it is in accordance with our dark skies policies.

Section 10 of the application form mentions two new parking spaces will be provided but I cannot see any other reference to this anywhere else.

Can the applicant demonstrate where these additional parking spaces will be?
