Dear Mr.Muir,

Further to your visit last week to look at siting for our shepherds hut application I thought I would send you this as an example of what we are hoping to achieve visually as it is so difficult to explain without pictures.

This actual hut is for sale and should we be able to agree a way of siting it that was ok with yourselves we would most probably buy this if its still available.

We like the natural larch finish to this as it will fade to a silver grey and match our existing buildings further down the field.

We also like the traditional lead and bitumen finish to the top part as we think it is very authentic and would blend into the existing hedge and Bankside behind it.

It is possible ,though not easy on this particular hut to remove the wheels and stand the chassis on blocks which would lower the roofline hence making it less visible from the main road.

It occurs to me that we could also lower it a bit more by digging out rather than lifting one end when we are levelling it and with the correct screening from the existing trees along with some sympathetic hedging or hurdles I think

It would be hardly noticeable.

I hope this helps you see what we are aiming to achieve and any comments from yourself would be most appreciated.
