


This will not be blue as the picture reference but brown with black shingled roof, this has a very similar footprint to the 6 meter bell tent, image below, the living area is smaller than the tent but having the benefit of 2 separate bedroom areas.

Cabin number 2




The cabin below has a slightly smaller footprint than the 5m tent which is currently pitched, no sanitary will be installed, it will use the existing wet room from last season.
