Here are the following dimensions,

The Yurt – 4.8 metres and 3 metres at its highest point. The Hot Tub is 1.7 metres diameter and 80cm tall, The BBQ cover is 1 metre wide and 2 metres long and 2.8 metres high.

The Game Larder – 2.7 metres x 2.7 metres x 3 metres tall. The Hot Tub is 2 metres long and 65cm wide.

Gypsy Wagon – 1.5 metres x 2.4 metres x 2.8 metres.

Crumbleclive – 3 metres x 3.6 metres x 3 metres. The Hot tub is 2 metres x 60 cm.

Hope this is ok and look forward to hearing from you.

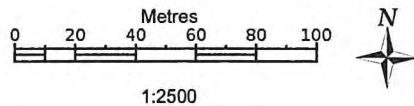

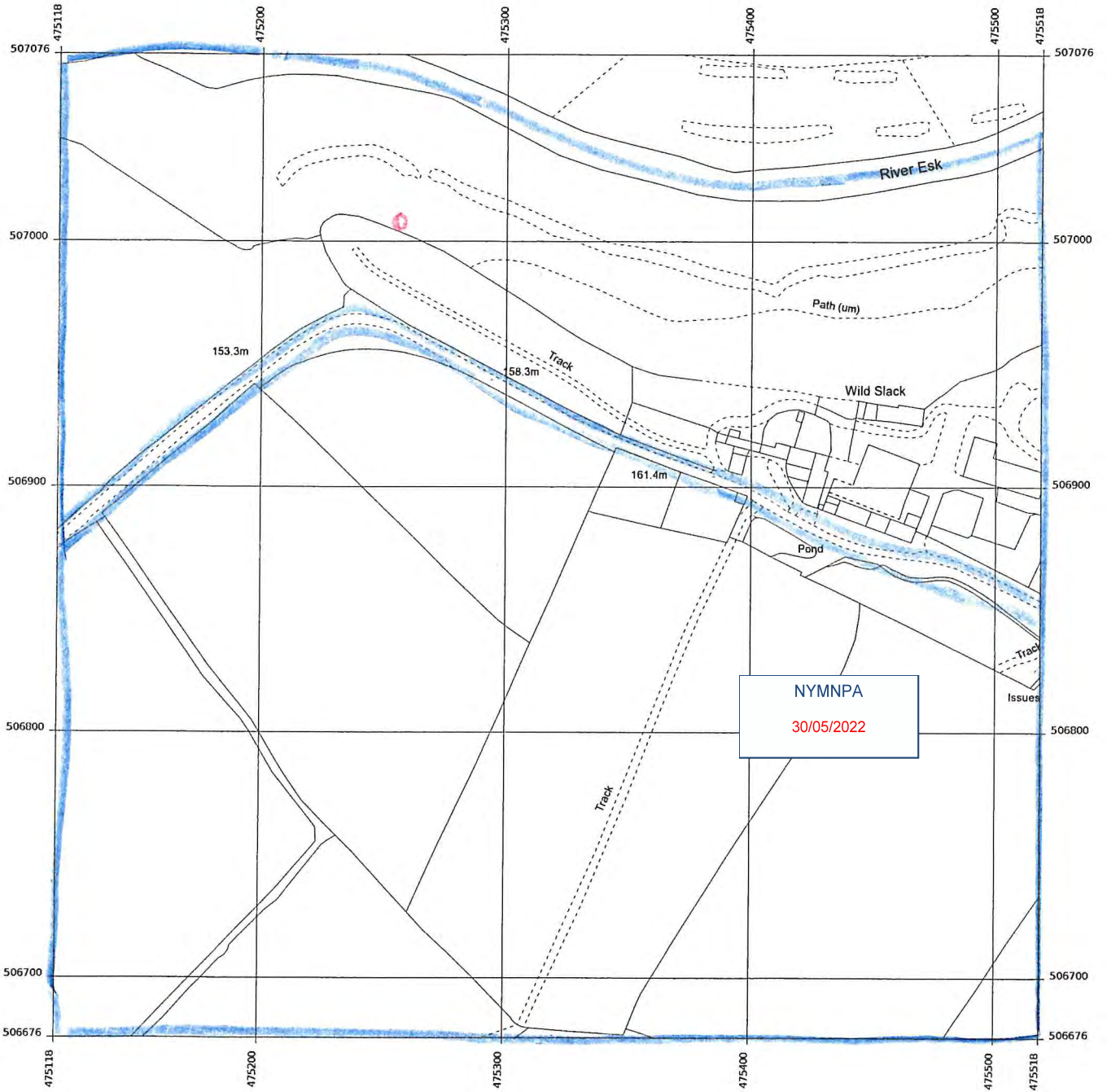

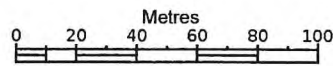
