We own and live in Snowdon Nab Farm House, which is adjacent to the proposed barn conversion NYM 2022/0481. We are not opposed to the development but after having studied the plans in detail we have a couple of concerns that we would like clarification on.

Most importantly water supply, we have a very limited spring water supply which we have to supplement most years during August and September, but this year also through June and July.

I would like to understand what the plans are for the water supply to the barn conversation and to ensure that it will not impact on our supply.

We spoke with NY Planning on the phone today and were told water supply was not within the scope of this application, but I find this strange because a previous application in 1998, NYM/32/172/PA, was refused on 4/3/98, because of insufficient water supply.

Also detailed in the planning history of this application.

As you would expect we find this a little confusing & would just like confirmation that a new supply is intended for the development.

The proposed sewage treatment is very close to the boundary of our property which is quite concerning. Is there any way that this could be looked into? If possible we would like it to be repositioned further towards the intended garage of the developed barn.

We have a concern about the lane which leads down to the property as it is currently in a very poor state of repair and would only get worse with building traffic. Could you please look into whether there are any intentions to address this.
