Consultee response

• Regarding the timber cladding, this was discussed on a site visit and is preferred over the buff mock stone cladding. This will create a contemporary design feature with nods to modern agricultural architecture within a traditional rural setting. I ask the applicant to provide further details on finish and colour.

• Timber canopy should be acceptable subject to design and finish. I ask the applicant to provide dimensions and proposed materials, such as timber and steel or timber and lead flashing, for example. To create a seamless appearance, I would suggest the timber element matches the new vertical timber cladding, finish/colour for example.

- No comment on retention of window opening.
- No comment of the revised footprint.

• Regarding the extra roof light, which is a consequence of the footprint alterations – a second directors office – it is not as justified as the others, due to ample light gain from two windows, a door and one roof light. I highlight this as a concern due to the numerous roof lights already permitted and the impact they have on the

highlight this as a concern due to the numerous roof lights already permitted and the impact they have on the character of the setting and dark skies initiative (although solar control film has been agreed). So to keep this impact to a minimum, I ask the extra roof light be omitted.
