Hi Lucy,

The development is surrounded priority woodland habitat, and there is potential for wildlife to be using the site. However, given the scope of the works, and the existing use of the site, it is unlikely that they will be substantially impacted by the development. A breeding bird informative should be included in any consent. Any materials should be stored on hardstanding or raised off the ground to prevent animals sheltering underneath, and any below ground works should be covered overnight, or a ramp added to ensure no animals are stuck within. No external lighting should be included.
