Holding Comment

Friars Cottage is a grade 2 listed mid 18th century cottage. It is constructed of finely herringbone-tooled coursed sandstone under a pantile roof. It is in the Robin Hoods Bay Conservation Area. Therefore, this application has been determined in accordance with Section 66 and 72 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990. Chapter 16 of the NPPF paragraphs 189, 194, 195 and 200, as well as Policy ENV11 (1) of the North York Moors National Park Authority Local Plan (2020).

This application is a result of a pre-application discussion with the previous Conservation Officer. The majority of the windows are un-sympathetic late 20th century replacements, the ground floor windows are believed to be in the style of early 20th century windows. The windows are suitable to be replaced with slim line double glazing or vacuum sealed as the proposal suggests, in timber. We will however need to see joinery details for window replacements as is common for listed buildings.

Just one thing of note, we are aware of previous discussions with the Conservation Team, however the applicants have an opportunity here to further enhance the setting of the listed building by putting windows back of a more appropriate design. There is no control over this as the current windows are already in place, however, it is just a consideration for the applicants.
