UNDER THE CONSTRUCTION DESIGN AND MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS 1994:

Site to be protected to prevent public occess to work. Health and Safety Executive to be notified of project by the planning supervisor.

Health and Safety Executive to be notified of any works involving demolition by the planning supervisor. Work adjacent/in highway. Qare to be token for safety of

pedestrions and operatives. Use traffic management i.e. barriers, signs, lights etc. Operatives to wear high visibility clothing.

Take precautions to prevent contact with any overhead cables. Contractor to provide for safe lifting and manoeuvring of timber trusses.

Contractor to ensure appropriate manpower/machinery available for lifting heovy or awkward materials. Consideration should be given to using high strength lightweight

trench blocks with hand holes where possible. All sharp ends of reinforcing bors/mesh to be protected, e.g.

by use of plastic caps. Sofe occess to roof plant and maintenance of i.e. windows, cleaning/pointing.

Provide sofe access ladder with safety hoops and foll arrest system.

Foll arrest system to be fitted to roof for mointenonce purposes if any plont or equipment is located on the roof. Provision to be mode for maintenance and cleaning windows hook points (if used) to be maintained and tested periodically. Due care and attention to be token with regard to the public if footpaths/public areas/roads ore closed off and/or

motorised equipment used for maintenance and cleaning purposes. Consider times for this purpose to suit public/opening times, troffic etc.

Consideration to be given to access for maintenance of ceiling mounted fittings, i.e. drop down fittings.


Permonent roof edge protection to be considered if maintenance access is required for plant or machinery. Windows to be hinged to enable cleaning to be undertaken internolly.

Contractor to toke account of COSHH Regulations in respect to <sup>1</sup> materials and sofe methods contaminated water and associated diseases.

Controctor to take account of making excessive noise,

particularly during unsocial hours.

Contractor to prepare o method for working in the confined site oreo.
