#### Manor House Farm, Troutsdale

With my apologies for taking so long to respond and as a further follow up to your recent letter about the proposed reconstruction and conversion of the barn at manor House Farm, I enclose a set of revised drawings which I hope answer the queries that you raised and I also reaffirm some previous answers:

- 1. Materials This list of materials is exactly how we would approach the scheme so I am happy to confirm this but would not expect to go into technical details of construction till we are at Building Regulations stage so we are happy that these could be a condition attached to an approval.
- Creation of a new doorway The internal layout has been revised to reinstate an old blocked up doorway and to introduce a matching one on the opposite gable as you suggested. We have removed the second doorway on the west elevation but would like to introduce a small window here to give some light into a dark corner – I do not think that this is out of place.
- 3. Plans not matching? I think that everything matches on the revised drawings.
- 4. Omitting the lantern lights and substituting rooflights not so good but perfectly possible. The east elevation has been changed to show 4 conservation style rooflights (by the Rooflight Company) but we would still prefer to reintroduce some larger areas of glazing as you appeared to agree with in a previous letter as follows "In one paragraph you say that, in your opinion, the patent glazed area should be omitted whereas, in the previous paragraph you say that you would support an area "being fully glazed to create more light into the upper floor" we would obviously like to add more glazing as we had previously indicated and these two comments appear to be contradictory Can you clarify this point please?
- 5. Only one cart door? We have adapted the plans to show a majority of existing openings with only one "cart opening" introduced. We still believe that it would not have been in the least unusual for a farm building of this size to have more than one larger opening. In fact a complete "arcaded" frontage with a series of cart openings would not have been

unusual. I would still hope that you would reconsider the introduction of at least one more cart size opening. I think that the fact that this elevation had been concealed behind other long gone farm buildings makes any significance to its current appearance fairly unimportant in the overall farm complex.

6. No stone wall to divide the patios? I agree – a timber fence would be better.

Further copies of the plans as existing re 1711/01 to 06 are attached plus revised plans as proposed nos. 1711/07B, 08A, 09A, 10A and 12A are attached which I hope will enable you to process the application and grant an approval. I also hope that you can agree to the other possible variations that we have proposed.







Location - Aerial View







Stone Barn - First floor layout as existing








Stone Barn - Elevations as Proposed 1.
