In assessing the submitted proposals and reaching its recommendation the Local Highway Authority (LHA) has taken into account the following matters:

Within planning applications NYM2020/1018/FL and SBC20/02831/FL, the LHA expressed its concerns about the safety hazards for pedestrians using the access onto the A174 on the north side of the beck. Alternative arrangements were designed and approved to install a footbridge for pedestrians to use the access on the south side of the beck. In these applications and NYM/22/0155 details were shown providing a footbridge to enable pedestrians to cross onto the south side of the beck and wooden railings to deter pedestrians going from the footpath to the northern access. The installation of the footbridge and anti pedestrian works on East Row bridge were conditioned as part of these planning applications. However, these works have still to be installed. despite the car park being available.

On the understanding that the conditions for these works are still valid, the LHA are satisfied that pedestrians will have a route avoiding the northern side of East Row Bridge and the LHA has no further objections.
