The LHA have considered the use the application site currently holds and the use that would be permitted if the application is approved.

The use that the site already holds is detailed in the decision notices of previous approvals:

NYM/2018/0177/FL details the items that are permitted to be sold;

NYM/2021/0999/FL gives approval for the extension of the building.

The LHA appreciate that different items would need to be delivered to the premises by different arrangements. The LHA would object to a significant increase in vehicles travelling up and down New Road. However, as the approval for the size of the building has already been granted, the LHA would view any deliveries being made to stock up part of the building with one type of goods would be in line with the reduction of deliveries that would be otherwise made for the other goods.
