## Tree/s in Conservation Area – Scalby

Thank you for the notification of your intention to carry out work to tree/s at Low Hall Cottage, Hackness Road, Scalby, Scarborough, YO13 0SD which was received by this office on 16 February 2024.

I can confirm that the North York Moors National Park Authority has no objection to the following work:

• Fell roadside sycamore - large amounts of basal bark killed and extensive dieback in crown

If you are not the owner of the tree/s (usually the landowner of the land on which the tree/s stand/s), please ensure that the owner is happy for you to carry out this work.

As stated in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas), the above permission is subject to a six week notification period, with the details recorded in a register open to public inspection. Therefore, after a six week period from the date of notification has elapsed (which would mean after 29 March 2024) subject to no objections being received, the work noted above may be carried out within a period of two years without further reference to myself.
