It is essential, therefore, that the plans are sufficiently clear so that the details of the proposal can be easily seen when projected onto the screen.

If the plans are not clear resulting from, for example, discoloured paper or particularly fine line drawings it may be difficult for Members of the Committee to appreciate fully the details of the scheme which could result in a delay in the determination of an application if Members consider it appropriate to seek further clarification of aspects of the development proposed.
