We have reviewed the information submitted with the application and we require more information for conditions 88 and 93 before we are satisfied with the discharge of conditions. We have no objections or concerns to any other conditions listed. Our detailed comments are as follows.

#### Planning Condition 88 - Hydrogeological Risk Assessment - Ladycross Plantation The Ground Water & Surface Water Monitoring Scheme covers most of Condition 88 relating to groundwater with the following exceptions, which are not addressed:

- "A protocol for the removal and replacement of any existing monitoring points " - no reference to removal or replacement of existing monitoring points for Phase 8 works
- o "Monitoring of groundwater levels and spring flows" Section 3.6 on monitoring spring flows is missing
- "Details of the method and frequency with which monitoring results will be shared with the MPA and the Environment Agency " this is not covered by section 4 and details need to be provided

# Planning Condition 93 - CEMP - Phase 8 Ladycross Plantation Construction **Environmental Management Plan**

The above document states "As part of the Phase 8 works, there is no requirement to excavate topsoil or subsoil on site". The applicant should discuss the potential for
