Please find attached the updated elevation plans for your information, sorry for the delay.

With regards to the planting scheme the Lockey family have confirmed that they would plant a mixed native hedge along the south and east boundary as shown the site plan attached and the hedge will be a mixture of Blackthorn, Field Maple, Dog Rose, Hazel and Hawthorn hedge plants which will be established in accordance with DEFRA guidance and standards as shown below:

- carry out work between 1 November 2024 and 31 March 2025
- prepare the ground along a 1.5m wide strip to provide good soil conditions and as little competition from other vegetation as possible.
- apply herbicide to the 1.5m strip in the August or September prior to planting.
- plants will be:
 - 2-year-old transplants
 - at least 450 millimetres (mm) to 600mm high
 - native species, with no one species making up more than 70% of the total.
 - planted in a staggered double row 40 centimetres (cm) apart with a minimum of 6 plants per metre.
 - kept clear of weeds until they are established.
- remove individual guards and tree shelters once the plants are established.
- trim the newly planted hedge in at least the first 2 years to encourage bushy growth, allowing the hedge to become taller and wider at each cut
- prevent livestock and grazing animals from damaging the hedge.
