Hi Wendy

The proposal appears to be replacing broken concrete surfacing on the PROW (public footpath) so I can't foresee any issue with it in principle.

However, whilst the work is being carried out and until the concrete surfacing can be walked upon, there must remain at all times a safe passage through for walkers using the public footpath. If a safe passage can't be maintained then the landowner/applicant will have to apply for a temporary path closure order. This will incur costs for them so I'd recommend they try to avoid having to go down this route.
