I have been a client of Gibbon Brothers since they started trading 15 years ago, and have witnessed them become an important engineering company within the Whitby area supplying many businesses with their expertise in design, metal fabrication, and engineering solutions. To lose this skill set due to a planning objection would be a loss to business, the local economy and the local community.

As you are aware, Gibbon Brothers were forced to relocate due to the redevelopment of their premises into a retail site, and have had great difficulty finding a suitable workshop.
